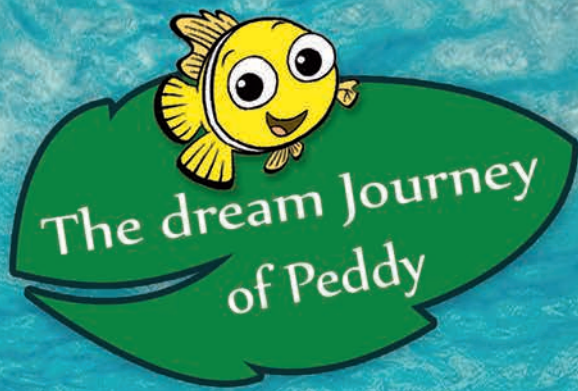

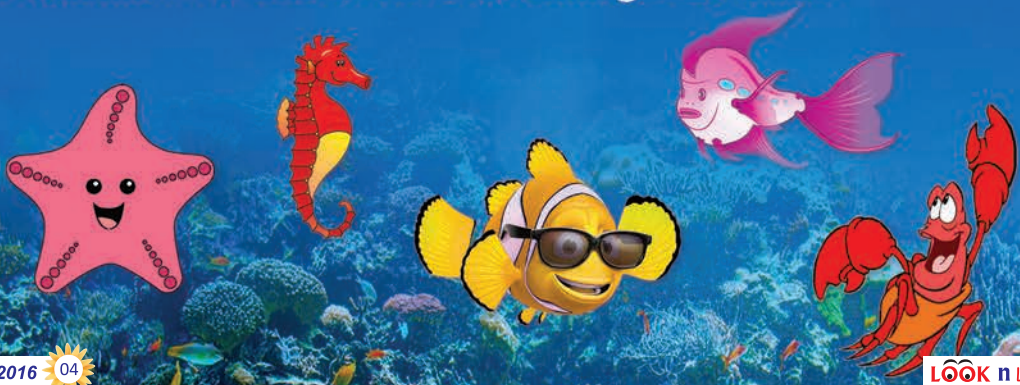

He was positive, he had setup a goal. He dreamt and cherished to live that dream, to fulfill that dream.

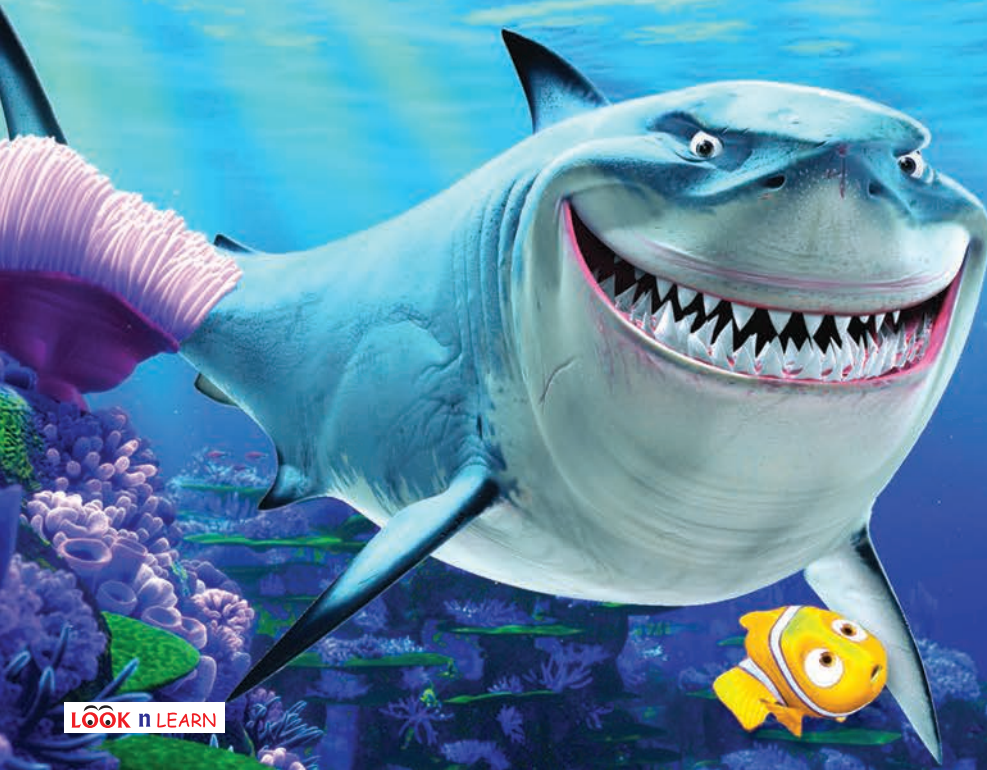
He had full faith in himself. No matter what the controversies may be, he decided to fulfill his dreams.

The big fish said, “Sorry Peddy, but I cannot let you go. It's my lunch time, you should've stayed below”.

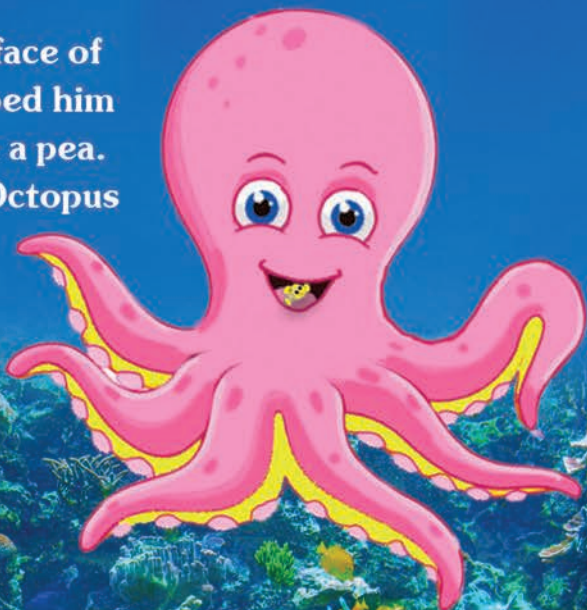


Peddy cowered back in fear and shook from fin to fin, but then he saw a school of fish called glin & with all cleverness he tried to escape from there.


