I'm the fastest runner

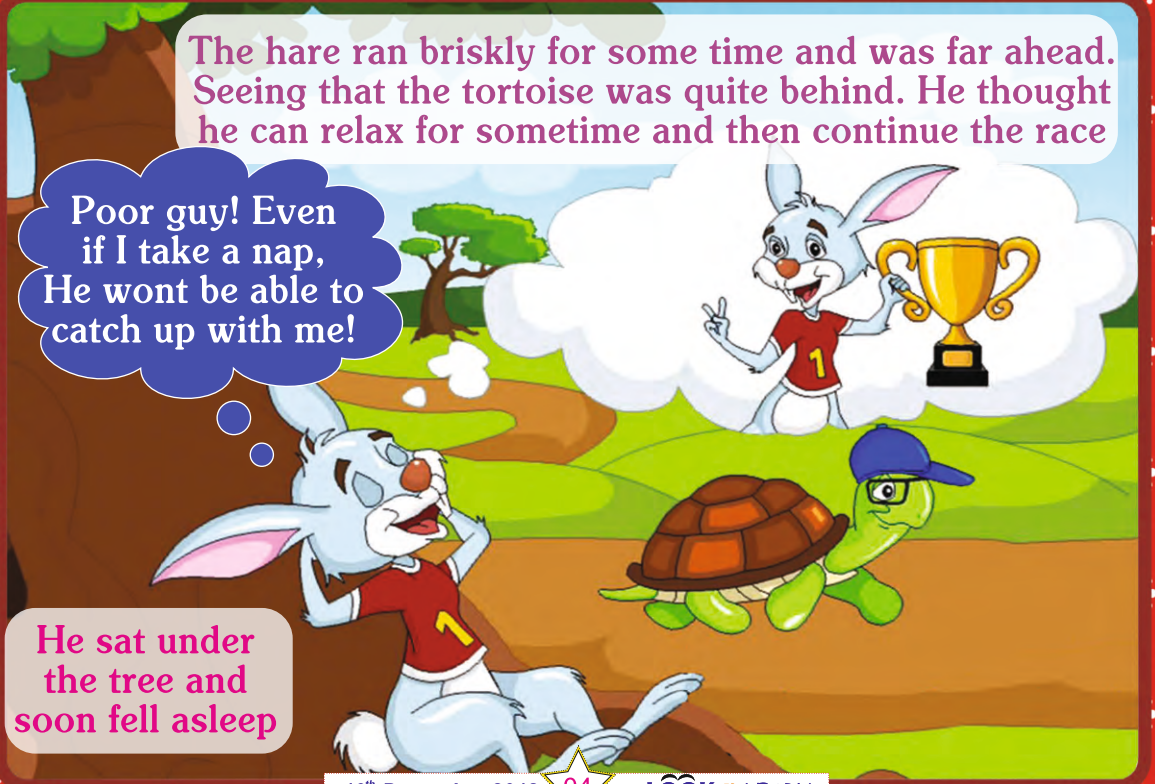
That's not true

They decided to settle the argument with a race and agreed on a route to start off the race

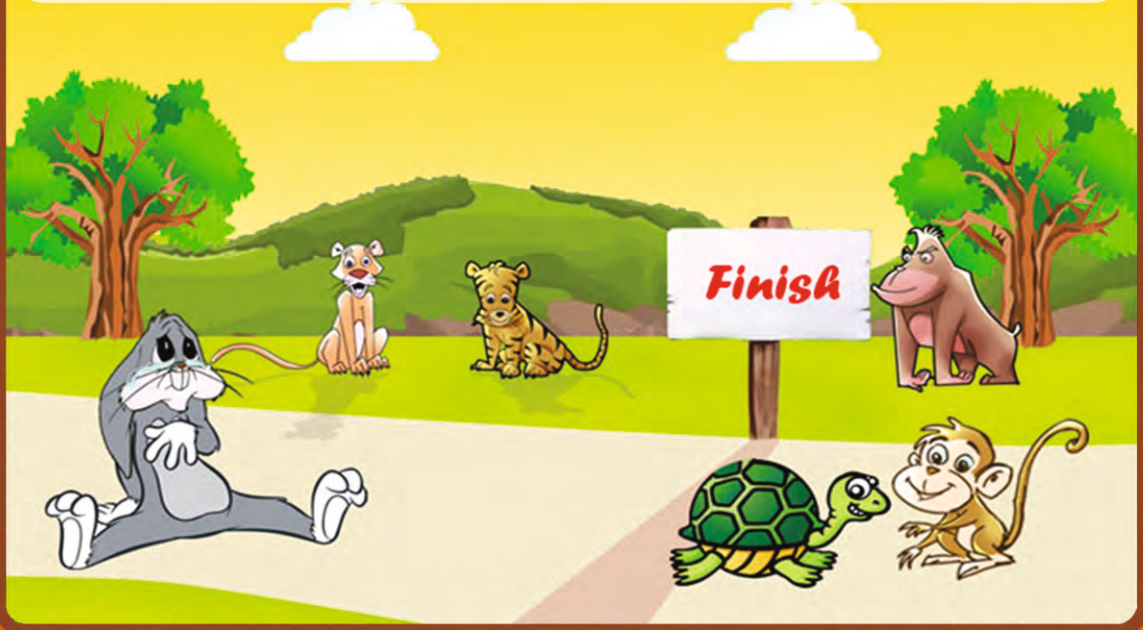


The hare ran briskly for some time and was far ahead. Seeing that the tortoise was quite behind. He thought he can relax for sometime and then continue the race

Poor guy! Even if I take a nap, He wont be able to catch up with me!



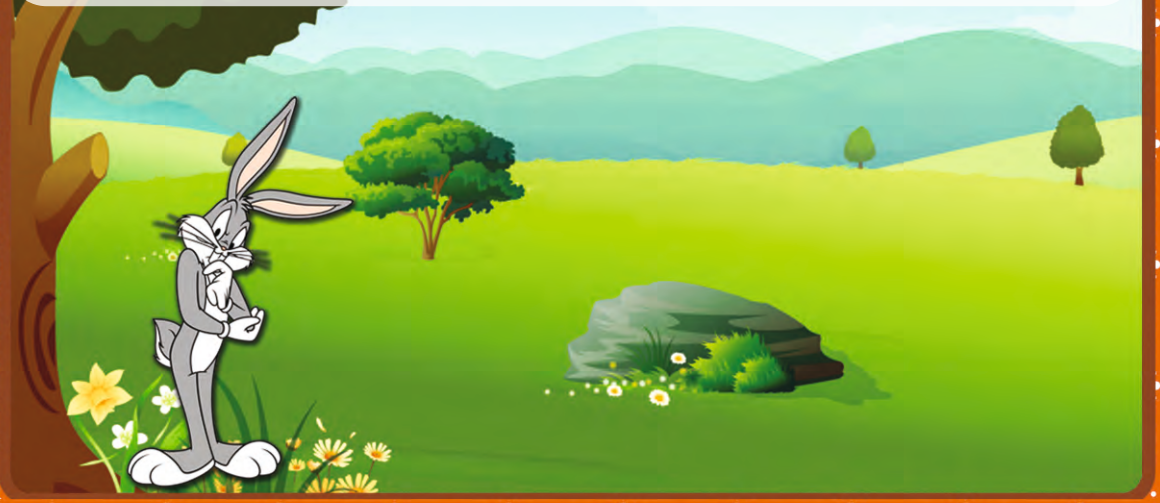
The tortoise over took and soon finished the race, emerging as an undisputed champ. The hare woke up and realized that he'd lost the race

The tortoise now realized that there's no way he can beat the hare in the race, the way it was currently set.



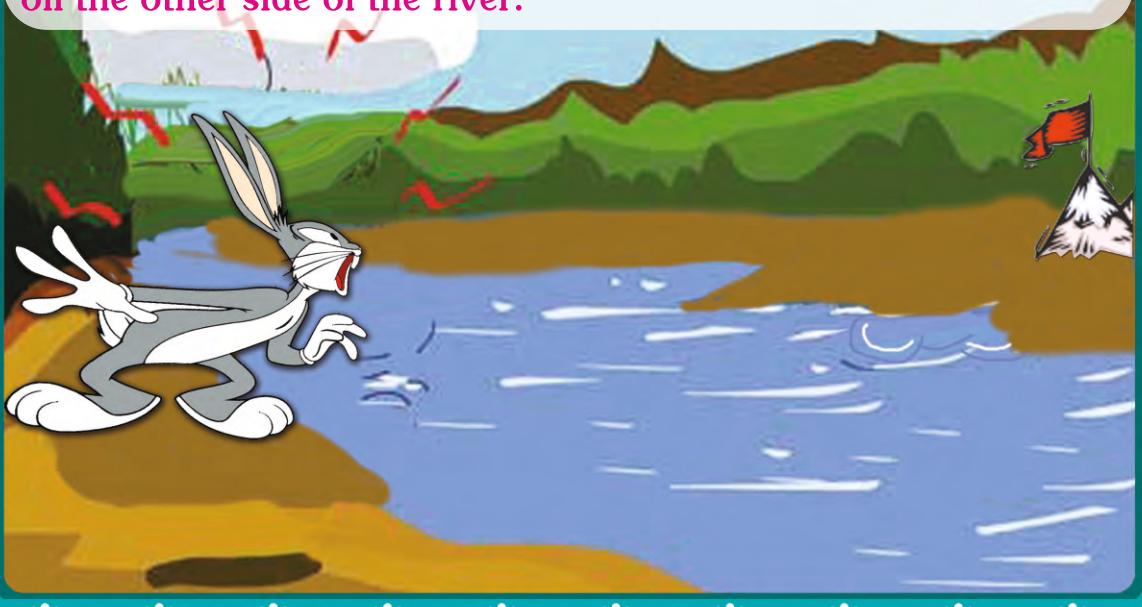
How can I win the race?



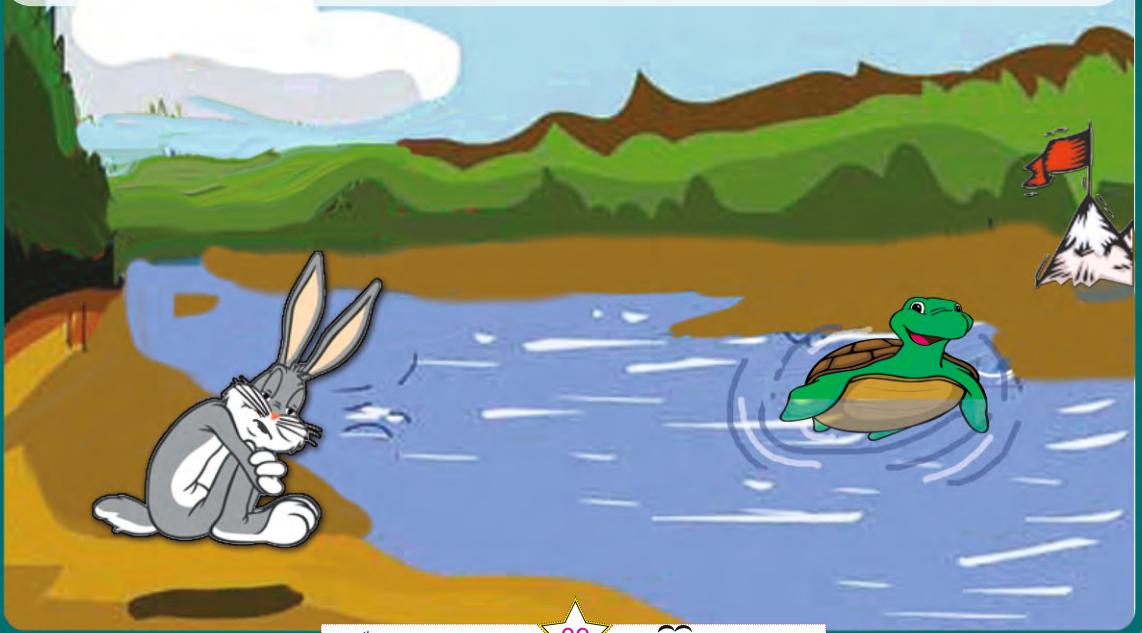
Can we have another race? This time we'll go through a different route.

The story still hasn't ended...

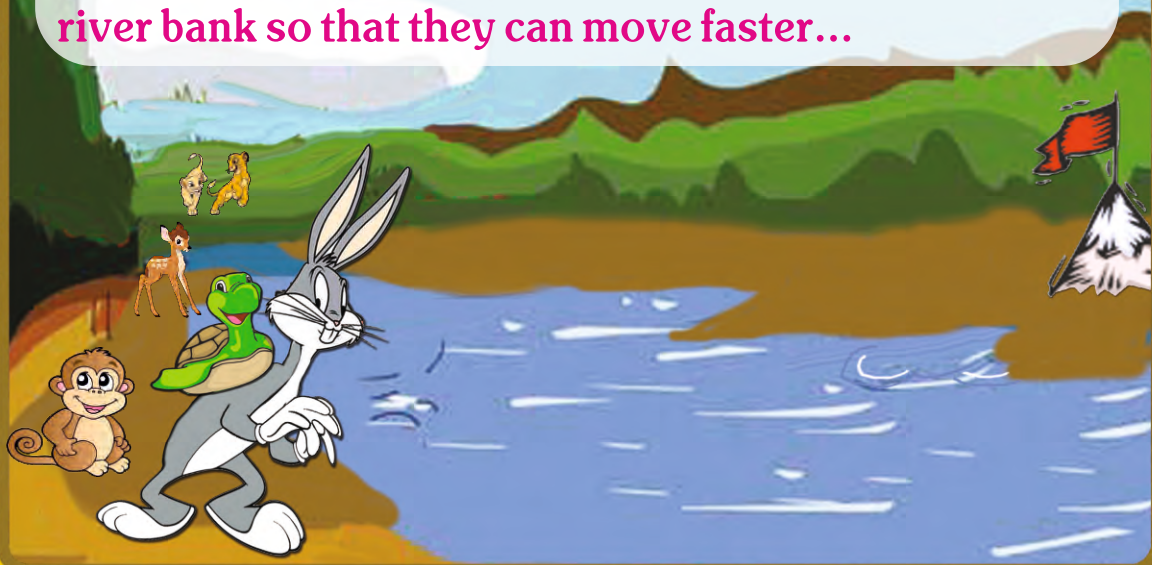
By this time the tortoise and hare had become pretty good friends and both realized that the last race could have been better.



So they decided to do the last race again, but this time all the animals from the jungle decided to take part in the race.



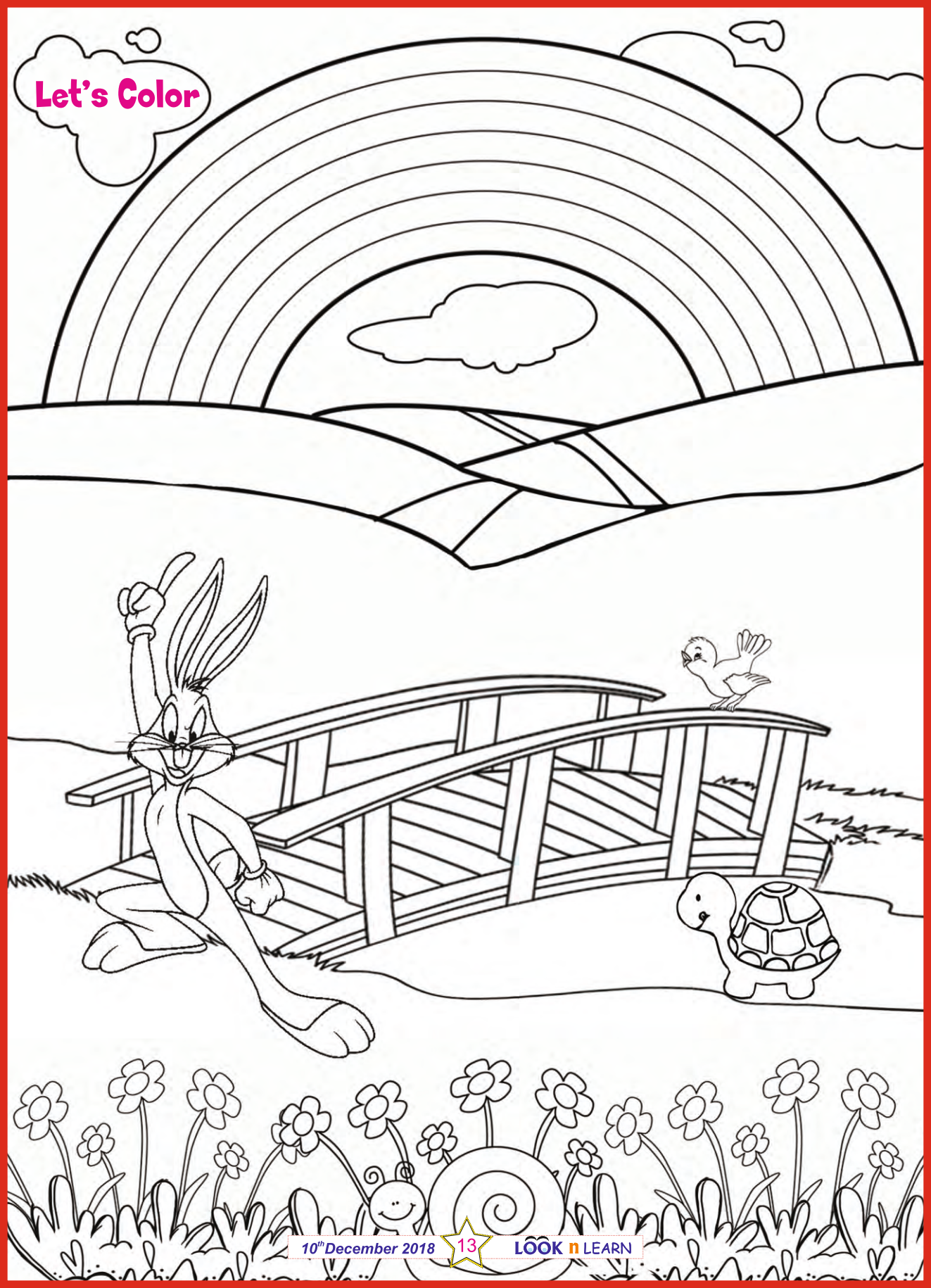
